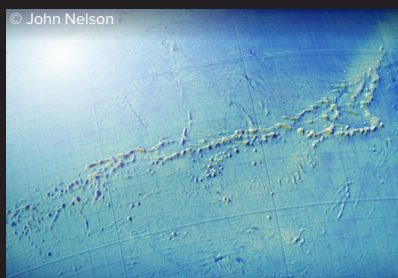

A geological formation dating back over **27 million years**



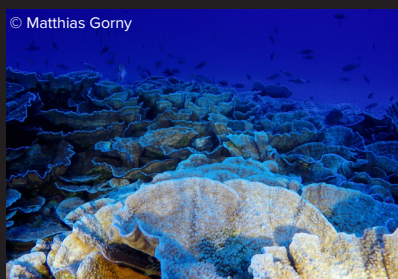

Home to some of the deepest photosynthetic habitats on Earth at over **300 m**



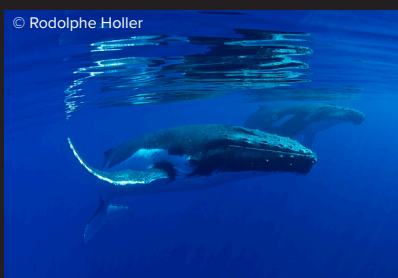

Over **110 seamounts**, which are some of the most biodiverse and productive ocean ecosystems



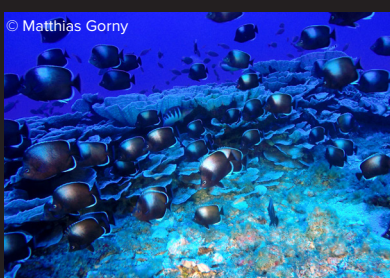

Home to over **80 threatened or endangered species**



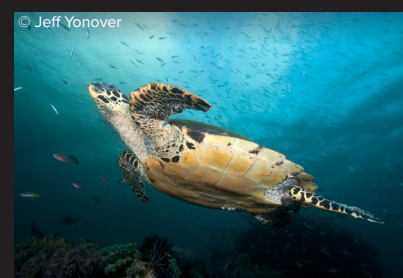
